

1. The doors are delivered packaged and protected with protective foil in order to ensure product quality during transportation.
2. Handling of the doors in warehouses, as well as loading, unloading and transport to the customer, must be carried out with the utmost care to prevent impacts, pressure marks, scratches or any other type of damage.
3. Both in intermediate storage facilities and at the customer's premises, the doors must be stored in covered, well-ventilated areas, protected from precipitation, moisture and direct sunlight.
4. The doors must be stored at a distance of approximately **100–150 mm from the floor** to prevent moisture absorption.
5. Wooden doors must not be stored in locations exposed to direct sunlight.
6. In strongly illuminated storage areas, wooden doors must be protected with light-impermeable materials.
7. Wooden doors must not be stored in areas with high humidity or extreme temperatures, as prolonged exposure may result in material damage.
8. The optimal storage environment for wooden doors is a room with a **relative humidity of 55–60%** and a **temperature between 10°C and 25°C**.
9. Doors must be transported using appropriately equipped, covered and properly secured transport vehicles in order to prevent friction and damage during transport.
10. Failure to comply with these instructions may result in the loss of warranty claims.
